Prior John Moloney dies

Following an extended illness which struck just a short time after his arrival at St. James, the Rev. John H. Moloney died Wednesday, March 18, 2009. A requiem Eucharist was held Monday, March 23 at St. James. Interment will be in the columbarium at Grace-St. Luke's in Memphis.

Father John Moloney grew up in Shreveport, attending Roman Catholic schools and monastery. He married his wife Carol in 1979 and they soon discovered the Episcopal Church. John attended seminary at the University of the South graduating in 1986.

He later became rector of the Church of the Epiphany, New Iberia where he served for seven years. He then served on the diocesan staff of Bishop Hargrove in the Diocese of Western Louisiana as Prior and Archdeacon where much time was devoted to the campaign and renovation of Camp Hardtner.

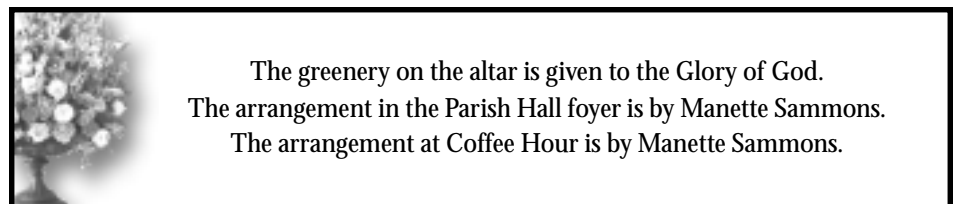

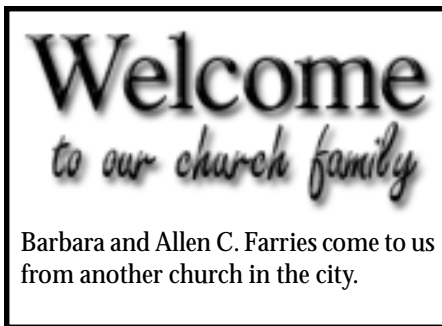

After eight years on Bishop Hargrove's staff, he became the rector of Grace-St. Luke's in Memphis, a corporate sized parish and day school where he served for over seven years.

Immediately before moving to St. James and Baton Rouge, Prior John had been on sabbatical working on a doctorate in liturgy from the Graduate Theological Foundation and Christ Church College at the University of Oxford, England.

Prior John headed the St. James Center for Spiritual Formation where he instituted the Fifth Sunday program, refocused the administrative and program boards and began planning several future events.

In addition to his wife Carol, John is survived by their two adult sons, Sean and Kyle, both of whom remain in Tennessee attending the University of Memphis.
