## CHOOSING A NEW BISHOP

What qualities are we Episcopalians looking for in our next chief pastor to replace retiring Bishop Charles Jenkins? Do you have an opinion on the current status of affairs in the diocese? Want to learn about the selection process?

**Plan to attend a town-hall meeting scheduled for Monday, May 4 in Bishops Hall.** Registration begins at 6:30 with the forum to run from 7:00 to 9:00 p.m.

This meeting is for lay persons only in the Baton Rouge area. (Three other area meetings will be held in the following weeks.) The Episcopate Committee that guides the initial diocese evaluation and candidate search wants to hear from **you!**

You may also participate in a short survey about the election and diocese at [www.edola.org](http://www.edola.org). The survey is available until April 30.

Nominations for the Eleventh Bishop of Louisiana will be accepted between June 15 and July 31. An Election Convention is scheduled for December 5 at Christ Church Cathedral.

Consecration of the next bishop of Louisiana is planned for May 2010.

Children's Choir and Mastersingers will continue the entire month of May right up until Pentecost on May 31 this year.

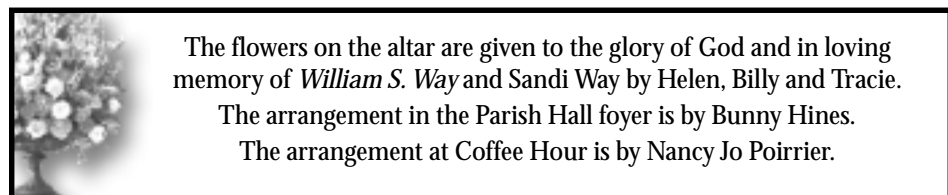

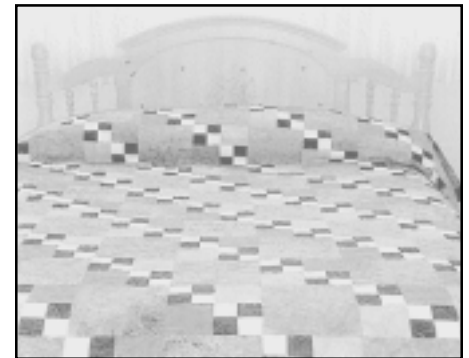
