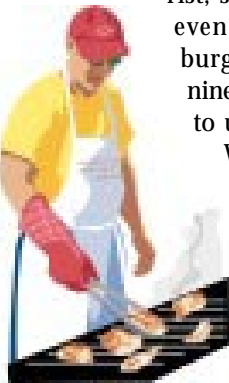

Fifth Sunday Feast

"I am the bread of life, you who come to me shall not hunger." Our Lord beckons you to come to church this Sunday, November 30, promising to fill a hungry heart and stomach.

At 10:00 a.m., we will roll up our sleeves and make Advent wreaths for our home dinner table. The Advent wreath has through the years been a popular family ritual used in place of the dinner blessing or bedtime prayers counting down the days of Advent to the Feast of the Nativity of our Lord, commonly called Christmas. A how-to book will be provided with each wreath.

Then at noon, following the 11:00 Holy Eucharist, sleeves will be rolled up even further to partake of burgers and dogs (non-canine) to celebrate Christ's call to us to live in community.

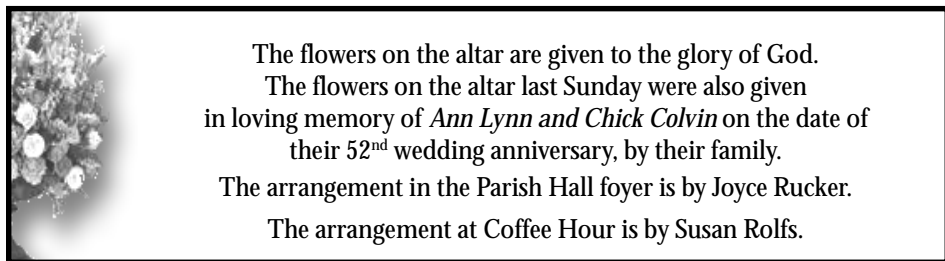

November Vestry Highlights

Prior John Moloney announced a new logo for the Center for Spiritual Formation which utilizes the St. James logo, colors reversed, and include a shell. Not only is the shell the symbol for St. James but also for baptism. The center will begin a Fifth Sunday series beginning on November 29 (*see cover story*). There will soon be other innovative programs to extend the reach and mission of The Center.

Fr. Mark Holland reported five baptisms at the Day School's All Saints Eucharist, bringing the number of baptisms to 44 for the year. Our parish success in number of baptisms is being recognized by the national church.

The vestry and associate vestry retreat, scheduled for the last weekend in February 2009, will include the CSF and Day School Boards.

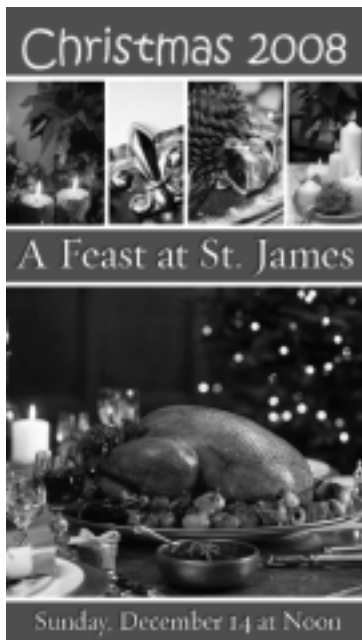
Church Mutual Insurance now estimates the cost of repairs caused by Hurricane Gustav to be closer to \$2 million.

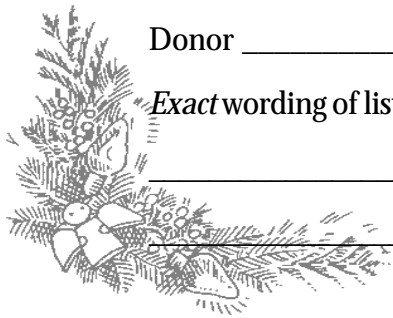
