## **Day School gets a Blue Ribbon for Excellence!**

St. James Episcopal Day School has been named a 2009 Blue Ribbon School of Excellence by U.S. Secretary of Education Arne Duncan.

St. James is the only private school in Louisiana, and the only Episcopal school in the nation to be honored this year!

The Blue Ribbon Schools program honors both public and private schools, although the application process and the selection criteria differ slightly for the two groups.

St. James had to demonstrate that it is an exemplary school in many areas, including having student test scores in the top 10 percent in the nation for the past five years.

Head of School Linda Chaviere and Assistant Head of School Beth Dauthier will attend the awards ceremony in Washington, D.C. in November where they will receive a plaque and flag for the school.

## Christian Education Notes

**Nursery Care** for children three months to four years old is available 8:30 a.m.-12:30 p.m. on the first floor of the Parish Hall. Pagers are also available for your comfort and convenience.

St. James offers two different Sunday programs for children as young as three years old. The **Catechesis of the Good Shepherd** is experienced in the **Good Shepherd Atrium** for children three years old through Kindergarten; and, the **True Vine Atrium** on the second floor of the Parish Hall for children in 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade. **Faith Builders** is a more familiar approach to Christian Formation for children. The younger children (pre-K- 3<sup>rd</sup> grade) meet on the first floor of the Parish Hall in two different classrooms; older children (4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, and 6<sup>th</sup> grade) meet on the second floor of the Parish Hall.
